
Psalm 91

3 Characters

- 1. Character 1 (vs 1, 3-13)
 - Declares the blessings of dwelling with the Most High
- 2. Character 2 (vs 2)
 - Declares his trust and refuge in the Most High
- 3. Character 3 (vs 14-16)
 - The Most High
 - Declares what He will do for him

The LORD is My Refuge & Fortress

- 1. What things will the Most High deliver him from?
 - a. **Snare** of the trapper
 - b. Perilous **pestilence** (3)
- 2. What images are given to demonstrate The Most High's protection?
 - a. A bird covering her chicks with her wings (Deut 32:11)
 - b. His truth is a **shield** and buckler
- 3. When the protected looks around he sees...
 - a. Thousands of wicked one with their reward

The LORD is My Refuge & Fortress

- 4. Why do these blessings come to him?
 - a. The Most High is his refuge and **dwelling place**
- 5. What is not going to happen to him?
 - a. No **evil** or plague
- 6. Why will evil not happen to him?
 - a. The Most High commanded His **angels** to keep him
- 7. What will he tread upon and trample?
 - a. The **lion** and **serpent**

The Most High Knows

He has set his **love** upon Him (14)

He has known **His name** (14)

Therefore, The Most High Will...

- a. **Deliver** him
- b. Set him on **high**
- c. **Answer** him
- d. **Be with him** in trouble
- e. Deliver him
- f. **Honor** him
- g. **Satisfy** him
- h. Show him salvation
