

1. The Real Story – 1 John 2:15-17, 24-27
  - *In order to grow into the godly men and women God intends for us to become, we must understand the nature of the world in which we live.*
2. The Battle Along the Way – Ephesians 6:10-18
  - *God gives you as a Christian everything needed to battle spiritual forces in the world.*
3. The Many Faces of the Journey – James 3:13-18
  - *Healthy relationship that honor God don't seek the approval of the world but rely on the wisdom and peace of God.*
4. Finding Clarity – Psalm 37:3-9
  - *Some of the greatest moments in your relationship with God are those when you stop thinking about you, choosing instead to let your mind and body rest in time spent alone with Him.*
5. The Way of the Journey – Philippians 2:5-11
  - *Deciding to surrender your life to God's will means living by His values instead of the world's.*
6. The Wrong Way – Hebrews 12:1-11
  - *In order to receive His grace and forgiveness when we sin, we must respond to God through confession and repentance.*
7. Navigating the Journey – Genesis 2:15-17; 3:1-6
  - *Knowing God and submitting to His authority in all decisions results in ultimate freedom.*
8. Solving the Maze – Psalms 19:7-11; James 1:22-25
  - *Regularly reading and studying the Bible reveals promises, principles, and truths for making critical decisions.*
9. Reflecting Christ Through the Journey – John 16:5-16
  - *Guiding the believer to live in such a way as to reflect Christ in all areas, the Holy Spirit is with us.*
10. Obstacles Along the Way – Genesis 45:4-11; 50:15-19
  - *God uses everything we experience – even the most difficult circumstances – to accomplish His will and form our character for navigating the critical path.*
11. Leaning on Others in the Story – 1 Kings 12:1-14
  - *God places specific Christians in our lives so that we may be formed spiritually in a way that allows us to become the men and women God created us to be.*
12. Through the Labyrinth of Life – James 1:1-12
  - *Making the critical decisions amidst life's adversities requires a wisdom unavailable by any means other than God.*
13. Growing Through Adversity – James 4:13-17; Ephesians 5:15-19
  - *When your relationship with God is truly top priority, it is evident in how you decide to invest your time.*
