

1. So Near Yet So Far – Genesis 1:26-2:7
 - *God's character is more complex than anything we can imagine. He is holy and yet highly interested in having a relationship with us. We are created in God's image and as we know Him better we will appreciate ourselves, others, and Him in even greater measure.*
2. Name Dropping – Exodus 3:1-15; John 8:54-59
 - *God's names have great significance. "I AM" for instance, although mysterious, still reveals God as self-sufficient, eternal, and unchangeable. By looking at Jesus' life and by journeying with God throughout our own lives, we learn even more about God's character.*
3. Setting Perimeters – Exodus 19:10-25; Hebrews 12:18-24
 - *God sets boundaries to protect us; they remind us that we should approach Him with reverence, respect, and a willingness to receive revelation.*
4. Beyond the Big House – 2 Samuel 7:1-17; Acts 17:24-29
 - *God is not limited by time, space, or location. You can experience His presence everywhere, not just in buildings designed specifically for that purpose.*
5. Get the Message – 1 Kings 19:1-18
 - *God communicates with us in a variety of ways. By spending time with Him, we'll find it easier to recognize His voice.*
6. The Good, The Bad, and The Ugly – Job 39:26-40:14
 - *Bad things happen. When they do, we have to seek God's strength and insight while trusting that He is still in control.*
7. Mediator for Acceptance – Job 9:32-35; Hebrews 4:14-16
 - *Today we can approach God's throne with confidence because Jesus serves as our mediator.*
8. No Trivial Pursuit – Psalms 139:1-18
 - *No matter where you go, you cannot escape from God. He wants to be a part of your life, and He has devoted Himself to pursuing you.*
9. Decoding God's Directions – Isaiah 6:1-10
 - *When you need directions for life, forget the GPS. Go to God. Ask Him to point you in the right direction, and then obediently respond to His leading.*
10. A Force to Be Reckoned With – John 3:1-15
 - *The Holy Spirit is part of the Trinity. He leads us to new beginnings and guides us as we journey through life.*
11. I Heard a Rumor – Ephesians 3:1-13; John 14:8-11
 - *God desires to reveal more about who He is and what He wants for us. It's up to us to learn how to discern the revelations we receive.*
12. A Family Affair – Galatians 3:25-4:7
 - *Through faith in Christ, we can become children and heirs of God. Being in God's family comes with special privileges.*
13. Unsolved Mystery – Revelation 21:1-5; 1 Corinthians 13:9-13
 - *The pursuit of God is never-ending. As you face the future, keep seeking clues to His identity and character.*
