5. Making Forgiveness Real – Luke 15:11-32
 - *God's forgiveness of us models how we are to forgive others.*
6. Making God's Love Real – Genesis 33:1-11
 - *The act of giving and receiving forgiveness helps us to experience God's love.*
7. Dealing with Real Conflicts – Luke 10:38-42
 - *Biblical principles can be used to deal with conflicts in relationships.*
8. Believing in Real Change – Acts 15:36-41
 - *Jesus gives people the ability to change.*
9. Finding Real Mentors – 2 Kings 2:1-15
 - *Mentoring relationships can make valuable contributions toward spiritual growth.*
10. Real Equity – Philemon 4-21
 - *All believers have equal status as brothers and sisters in the family of God.*
11. Giving Real Support – Job 2:11-21; 6:14-21
 - *In times of crisis, real support comes from being present, sensitive, and careful with our words.*
12. Showing Real Confidence – 2 Timothy 1:1-14
 - *We are to help each other find our gifts and encourage each other to use those gifts.*
13. Real Greatness – Matthew 20:20-28
 - *Real greatness comes through personal sacrifice and servanthood.*
