### Lesson 4: Psalm 112

#### Introduction to Psalm 112:

- It is often called a “Hallelujah” psalm because it begins with “\_\_\_\_\_”
- It is an acrostic poem. Meaning each line begins with the next letter in the alphabet.
- It appears to be connected to Psalm 111. Specifically an exposition of Psalm 111:10

#### Who is blessed?

  - He will never be shaken/moved (Gen 13:14-17)
  - He will not fear evil tidings or his enemies (Gen 14; Gen 18)
  - His heart is supported (Gen 15:2-5)
  - His horn will be exalted with honor (Gen 17:4-7)

  - Gracious, full of compassion and righteousness (Gen 18:16-33)
  - He deals graciously with others and lends (Gen 14:16, 21-24)
  - Conducts his affairs with justice (Gen 21:22-34)
  - His heart trusts in the LORD (Gen 24:7,40)
